PHASE ONE – INDUSTRIAL LANDS

- The south of end of 41B road has undergone temporary road repairs to address the safety issues raised by membership. Information on the 41B road improvements, as well as future updates on road closures and construction activities can be found in the TFN/Matcon JV Look Ahead Schedule posted weekly in the Community Newsletter and on the corkboard behind the reception desk window.
- To date TFN has entered into 2 agreements with TMJV to fill the development sites contained within Phase 1 Industrial Lands and to complete the road fills required for the Phase 1 site servicing work.
