What is the A FROG program?

It's a place where families can interact with other children and parents/caregivers. An inviting atmosphere where you are able to enjoy quality time with your children away from home, as well as providing an opportunity for friendship, support and shared experiences with other adults. You can also experience some First Nations cultural awareness.

Is there a fee to attend?

The program is FREE. Donations will be accepted and go towards purchasing supplies.

How long is the program?

The A FROG is an ongoing drop-in program that operates in 2 hour sessions at each site throughout the entire year.

Who can participate?

Families and caregivers with children aged 0—6 years.

Where are we located?

We operate out of a refurbished school bus that parks at predetermined sites in the Surrey and Delta areas. We deliver services between 9:30—11:30 am and 12:30—2:30 pm Monday thru Thursday.
