Interpretation

1 In this regulation:

“**Act**” means the Education, Health and Social Development Act;

“**Effective Day**” means April 3, 2009;

“**Effective Day Treaty Benefit**” means the \$1000 payment made to every Tsawwassen Member over the age 19 as soon as is administratively possible following April 3rd, 2009;

“**Tsawwassen Member ordinarily receiving income assistance**” means a Tsawwassen Member who has received income assistance in more than 12 of the past 24 months.

Income status of Effective Day Treaty Benefit

2 Notwithstanding the Tsawwassen First Nation Income and Social Assistance Regulation, the Effective Day Treaty Benefit provided to all Tsawwassen Members over the age of 19 will have no effect on a Tsawwassen Member’s eligibility for income assistance.

3 For greater certainty, the Effective Day Treaty Benefit will not be counted as income for the purpose of determining eligibility for income assistance.

4 For greater certainty, if on the Effective Day, a Tsawwassen Member ordinarily receiving income assistance is not eligible to receive the Treaty Benefit as a result of income in previous months, the Effective Day Treaty Benefit will not be counted as income for the purpose of adding to the Tsawwassen Member’s period of ineligibility after the Effective Day.
