Cycling Path Signage Standards

On October 9, 2014, Executive Council passed an Order adopting TransLink's *Wayfinding Guidelines for Utility Cycling in Metro Vancouver* for use on existing and future trails throughout Tsawwassen First Nation Lands. The guidelines are a comprehensive resource for designing and signing cycling networks and are currently used throughout Metro Vancouver, including locations near Tsawwassen First Nation in the Corporation of Delta.

Developers may be required to provide signage if their project contains cycling paths or if they are constructing cycling paths near their project. The signage must conform to the standards set out in TransLink's *Wayfinding Guidelines for Utility Cycling in Metro Vancouver*, and must receive approval from the Director of Lands, or his or her delegate, prior to installation. Developers are free to choose their own contractors.
